

Timberwood Bank University

Overview



Timberwood Bank University is a seven-week financial education and scholarship program available to Tomah High School seniors through Timberwood Bank. Each course will be 60 minutes and includes established financial literacy materials as well as unique lesson plans created by Timberwood Bank staff and guest instructors. Space is limited for this no-cost program. Students must complete an entry application and be committed to attend, be engaged, and complete assignments on time.

Courses include:

- Welcome Night / Intro to TBU
- Insurance
- Identity Theft & Cyber Security
- Budgeting & Saving
- Economy & Credit
- Loans
- Planning for the Future / Class Review with Q&A

Each graduate will receive a \$250 academic scholarship if all program requirements are met. Each graduate also has the opportunity to earn greater scholarships through an essay contest that is judged by a bank committee. Students with the highest scores are the recipients of scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 for first place and \$750 for second place.

Course Schedule: 6:00-7:00pm, Wednesdays, February 13 through March 27, 2019.

Application Deadline: January 15, 2019

Scholarship eligibility requirements:

- Attendance for all seven courses. Students can make up one course by obtaining the materials and completing the course assignment.
- Complete all assignments.
- Submit an essay based upon criteria provided.

- A completion certificate
- Invaluable knowledge of personal finance
- A chance to be the essay contest winner and recipient of:
